### Mahouts

Without mahouts no elephants... The mahouts at Elephants World have a very important role, because they take care of the elephants. Because we have lack of money we can pay the mahouts only between 3000 and 4000 bath a month. For example, many elephant camps pay between 7000 and 8000 bath. This difference is too big, and causes a huge decline. If we can offer the mahouts a higher salary, they will stay at Elephants World and they become a real team together.

### Artificial insemination project

Dr. Samart wants to make a difference by starting an artificial insemination project of domesticated elephants. The purpose of this project is to protect the wild bulls in the forest (prevent that people will take them from the forest for breeding) and to counteract the severe inbreeding observed in many domesticated elephant populations in Thailand.
